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RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULT OF ELECTION
IN EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION
DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY OF YOLO

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 4th day of December, 1952, determined that a portion of the unincorporated territory of the County of Yolo hereinafter described was in need of fire protection and should be formed into a fire protection district under Division 12, Part 3, Chapter 2, of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors by resolution duly passed and adopted by said Board at said meeting fixed as the time and place for hearing of the matter of the formation of said district the 2nd day of January, 1953, and directed the Clerk of the Board to publish and post notice as required by law; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors on the 2nd day of January, 1953, by resolution duly passed and adopted by said Board at said meeting found and determined that there were no legal objections to the formation of said proposed county fire protection district and decided to establish a county fire protection district in Yolo County to be known as "EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT", in the County of Yolo, to consist of the following unincorporated territory within the County of Yolo embraced within the boundaries described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point where the most southerly City Limits line of the City of Davis intersects the centerline of Putah Creek along the north right of way line of Highway U. S. 40 and 99W; thence in a southeasterly direction from said point of beginning along the afore-said centerline of Putah Creek to County Road 104; thence ^{south} along County Road 104 to County Road 35; thence easterly along County Road 35 and extending easterly therefrom to the southeast corner of Section 25, T. 8 N., R. 3 E. M. D. B. & M.; thence north to the northeast corner of Section 36, T. 9N., R. 3E.; thence west to the 1/4 corner common to

1 Sections 34 and 27; thence north through the
2 center of Sections 27 & 22 to the north line
3 of said Section 22; thence west to the north-
4 west corner of Section 19 of said T. 9 N., R.
5 3 E.; said point also being the intersection
6 of Roads 27 and 104; thence south along County
7 Road 104 to County Road 29; thence west along
8 County Road 29 to the intersection of County
9 Road 102; thence south along County Road 102
10 to the intersection of County Road 31; thence
11 west along County Road 31 to the centerline of
12 County Road 101-A running southeasterly along
13 the westerly side of the Southern Pacific Rail-
14 road Right-of-way; thence southeasterly along
15 the centerline of said County Road a distance
16 of 1/4 mile more or less to the northerly City
17 Limits line of the City of Davis; thence follow-
18 ing the various courses of the City Limits Line
19 of the City of Davis along the north, east and
20 southeasterly boundaries to the point of begin-
21 ning; containing approximately 51.6 square miles.

22 WHEREAS, the said Board of Supervisors of the County of
23 Yolo, sitting in regular meeting on the 2nd day of January, 1953,
24 passed and adopted a resolution calling a special election to be
25 held in said county fire protection district on the 23rd day of
26 January, 1953, for the purpose of determining by the vote of the
27 qualified electors of said district the question as to whether said
28 EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT shall be established; and

29 WHEREAS, said resolution calling said election contained
30 and provided for all of the things required by law concerning the
31 holding of said election; and

32 WHEREAS, the notice of said election prescribed in said
resolution was duly published and posted in the manner and for the
length of time required by law and as directed by said Board of
Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and regularly held in
said proposed EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, as
directed by said Board of Supervisors, on the 23rd day of January,
1953; and

WHEREAS, the returns of said election have been filed
with said Board of Supervisors in the manner and form required by
law; and

1 WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo
2 has duly canvassed the said election returns of said election;

3 IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of
4 Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California;

5 1. That at the special election held in the hereinabove
6 described EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT in the County
7 of Yolo there was submitted to the duly qualified electors of
8 said district the proposition: "Shall the East Davis County Fire
9 Protection District be established", and opposite and to the right
10 of said proposal on the ballots voted at said election were
11 printed the words, "Yes" and "No" together with voting squares;

12 2. That there were thirty-nine (39) votes cast at said
13 election; that thirty-eight (38) votes were cast in favor of the
14 proposal and one (1) vote cast against said proposal, to form
15 said East Davis County Fire Protection District;

16 3. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo
17 find and determine, and it does hereby find and determine, that
18 at such election, that is to say, the election held in the herein-
19 above described East Davis County Fire Protection District on the
20 23rd day of January, 1953, a majority of the votes cast ratify
21 the declaration of said Board of Supervisors made on the 2nd day
22 of January, 1953, deciding to establish a county fire protection
23 district within the unincorporated territory in the County of Yolo,
24 State of California, hereinabove described, to be known as the
25 East Davis County Fire Protection District in the County of Yolo;

26 4. That this resolution making the aforesaid findings
27 be entered upon the minutes of said Board of Supervisors of the
28 County of Yolo forthwith and that thereafter said East Davis
29 County Fire Protection District in the County of Yolo, embracing
30 the unincorporated territory in the County of Yolo within the
31 boundaries hereinabove described, shall be deemed to be established
32 and organized, and shall, in fact, be established and organized

1 as a county fire protection district;

2 IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of
3 this Board is hereby authorized and directed to cause a certified
4 copy of this resolution, together with a map or plat indicating
5 the above described territory, to be immediately filed for record
6 in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Yolo,
7 the county within which the land situated in said East Davis
8 County Fire Protection District is wholly situated, and with the
9 Assessor of the County of Yolo, and with the State Board of
10 Equalization of the State of California.

1 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo,
2 State of California, on the 4th day of December, 1952, in a
3 regular meeting of said Board, resolved and ordered that that
4 certain portion of Yolo County, hereinafter described, is unincor-
5 porated territory within the County of Yolo and is in need of fire
6 protection and should be formed into a fire protection district
7 to be known as "EAST DAVIS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT IN THE
8 COUNTY OF YOLO", and in the said resolution found and determined
9 that said portion of the unincorporated territory of the County of
10 Yolo, hereinafter described, is not included in any forest land
11 protected by the State Board of Forestry of the State of California
12 or in any manner approved by the State Board of Forestry of said
13 State; and

14 WHEREAS, the said Board of Supervisors in the aforesaid
15 resolution provided and directed that the matter of the formation
16 of such county fire protection district should be heard by the
17 Board of Supervisors of Yolo County on Friday, January 2, 1953,
18 at 2:00 o'clock P. M., at the regular meeting place of said Board
19 of Supervisors of Yolo County in the Supervisors' Room, in the Yolo
20 County Courthouse situated in the City of Woodland, County of Yolo,
21 State of California, and fixed said time and place as the time and
22 place for the hearing of the matter of the formation of such fire
23 protection district; and

24 WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors, in the said resolu-
25 tion, ordered and directed that the Clerk of said Board publish
26 and post notice of the proposed formation of such district and
27 of the time and place of the hearing of the matter of the forma-
28 tion of said county fire protection district in the manner and
29 form required by law; and

30 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of said County of Yolo
31 hereby finds and determines that the Clerk of this Board did in
32 fact cause the said notice to be published and posted in the manner

1 and form as directed by this Board in said resolution and in
2 accordance with law; and

3 WHEREAS, this is the time and place fixed by said Board
4 in its aforesaid resolution for consideration of the matter of the
5 formation of said proposed East Davis County Fire Protection Dis-
6 trict in the County of Yolo; and

7 WHEREAS, this Board has fully considered the matter of
8 the formation of said County Fire Protection District, and determ-
9 ines that the project is feasible, economically sound and for the
10 public interest; and

11 WHEREAS, there have been no protests made orally or in
12 writing against the proposed formation of said fire protection
13 district by any person who owns or has an interest in property
14 which might be liable to assessment or taxation for the proposed
15 project or for the payment of expenses or obligations of the
16 district, should the district be organized, or by any other in-
17 terested person.

18 IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of
19 Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California, that said
20 Board of Supervisors decide, and it does hereby decide, to proceed
21 to create and establish said county fire protection district
22 under the Health and Safety Code of the State of California,
23 Division 12, Chapter 2, Part 3; that the said East Davis County
24 Fire Protection District in Yolo County, which the said Board of
25 Supervisors has herein and hereby decided to establish, shall con-
26 sist of all of that portion of the unincorporated territory
27 within the County of Yolo embraced within the following described
28 boundaries:

29 Beginning at a point where the most southerly
30 City Limits line of the City of Davis inter-
31 sects the centerline of Putah Creek along the
32 north right of way line of Highway U. S. 40
and 99W; thence in a southeasterly direction
from said point of beginning along the afore-
said centerline of Putah Creek to County Road
104; thence south along County Road 104 to.

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County Road 35; thence easterly along County Road 35 and extending easterly therefrom to the southeast corner of Section 25, T. 8 N., R. 3 E., M. D. B. & M.; thence north to the northeast corner of Section 36, T. 9 N., R. 3 E.; thence west to the 1/4 corner common to Sections 34 and 27; thence north through the center of Sections 27 & 22 to the north line of said Section 22; thence west to the northwest corner of Section 19 of said T. 9 N., R. 3 E.; said point also being the intersection of Roads 27 and 104; thence south along County Road 104 to County Road 29; thence west along County Road 29 to the intersection of County Road 102; thence South along County Road 102 to the intersection of County Road 31; thence west along County Road 31 to the centerline of County Road 101-A running southeasterly along the westerly side of the Southern Pacific Railroad Right-of-Way; thence southeasterly along the centerline of said County Road a distance of 1/4 mile more or less to the northerly City Limits line of the City of Davis; thence following the various courses of the City Limits line of the City of Davis along the north, east and southeasterly boundaries to the point of beginning; containing approximately 51.6 square miles.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the said proposed county fire protection district consists solely and entirely of unincorporated territory situated wholly within the County of Yolo, State of California, and does not include any forest land protected by the State Board of Forestry or in any manner approved by the State Board of Forestry.
